<a href="#">Vaccination evidence</a>	<p>Vaccination evidence must be in the form of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>written record of vaccination signed, dated, and stamped by a medical practitioner / nurse immuniser or pharmacist vaccinator (for authorised vaccines only) on the NSW Health Vaccination Record Card for Category A Workers and Students</li> <li><a href="#">Australian Immunisation History Statement</a></li> <li><a href="#">Australian COVID-19 Digital Certificate</a></li> </ul> <p>Note: If the Immunisation History Statement or Digital Certificate downloaded via <a href="#">MyGov</a> has an Individual Health Identifier (IHI) listed, remove/redact the IHI before sending. See <a href="#">YouTube video</a> for help.</p>	<p><b>AND / OR</b> Vaccination evidence must be in the form of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>serological confirmation of protection</li> </ul>	
<b>Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis</b>	One adult dose of diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis (dTpa) vaccine within the last 10 years. dTpa booster is required 10-yearly.	Serology will <u>not</u> be accepted.	
<b>COVID-19</b>	Students attending clinical placements are required to have two doses of a TGA approved or recognised COVID-19 vaccine.	Serological testing to demonstrate immunity against SARS-CoV-2 in vaccinated individuals will <u>not</u> be accepted.	
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	History of age-appropriate hepatitis B vaccination course. A full adult (≥20 years of age) course of hepatitis B vaccine consists of three doses, at either a 0, 1 and 4 month or a 0-, 2- and 4-month interval schedule (or if before July 2013 at 0, 1 and 3 months).	<b>AND</b> Anti-HBs ≥ 10mIU/mL <b>OR</b> <b>AND</b> Documented evidence of anti-HBc, indicating past hepatitis B infection, and/or HBsAg+.	
<a href="#">Hepatitis B Vaccination Declaration</a>	Completed Hepatitis B Vaccination Declaration is acceptable only if all attempts fail to obtain the vaccination record showing previous vaccinations.	-	
<b>Measles, Mumps and Rubella</b>	Two doses of measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine at least one month apart.	<b>OR</b> Positive IgG for measles, mumps, and rubella	
<b>Varicella</b>	Two doses of varicella vaccine at least one month apart (or evidence of 1 dose if the person was vaccinated before 14 years of age).	<b>OR</b> Positive IgG for varicella <b>OR</b> Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) History Statement that records natural immunity to chickenpox.	
<b>Influenza</b>	Annual influenza vaccination is mandatory for all clinical students attending placement between 1 June and 30 September each year. Students must receive the current southern hemisphere influenza vaccine registered for use by the TGA. <b>Note: If you have previously received Full Compliance but are missing your current season Flu vaccine, you must send your evidence to NSW Health as soon as possible to update your profile. Any student who has not provided a <u>current season Flu vaccination record by 1 June each year</u> will automatically revert to <u>Not Compliant</u> and be unable to attend placement.</b>	Serology will <u>not</u> be accepted.	
<b>Tuberculosis</b>	Ensure your doctor has completed <u>all</u> TB questions (Y/N) and sections on your Vaccination Record Card.	-	
<a href="#">Tuberculosis (TB) Assessment Tool</a>	Read, complete, and sign the form (Attachment 7). <u>All</u> students must complete the TB Assessment Tool (even if ticked 'No' for TB on your vaccination card).	Form must be signed and dated. Old form versions are <u>not</u> accepted.

<a href="#">Code of Conduct Declaration</a>	Read, complete and sign the form to agree to abide by the <a href="#">NSW Health Code of Conduct</a> .	Form must be signed and dated. Old form versions are <u>not</u> accepted.	
<a href="#">Australian National Police Check</a>	Apply for a National Police Check (must be valid for the completed duration of your course). Must be issued by an <a href="#">Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission (ACIC) accredited body</a> . National criminal record checks are valid for five years since the date of issue. If completing a placement outside of NSW, you may also need to apply for a police check in that state.	If a charge or conviction is listed, you must apply for a <b>Clinical Placement Clearance</b> . This application must be done within 3 months of your placement (evidence will be required).	
<b>Overseas Police Check</b>	Overseas students are required to provide a National Police Check from their home country or any country they have resided in since turning 18 years of age.	If overseas students cannot provide this police check, they can sign the <b>Overseas Student Statutory Declaration</b> . Please upload this to MyPlacement under Documents.
