

# Anaphylaxis e-Training

All students undertaking placement in a school are required to complete anaphylaxis training prior to placement. Training must be completed with either the Australasian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy (ASCIA) of the Department of Education (DoE).

Please follow the following steps to complete the ASCIA anaphylaxis training.

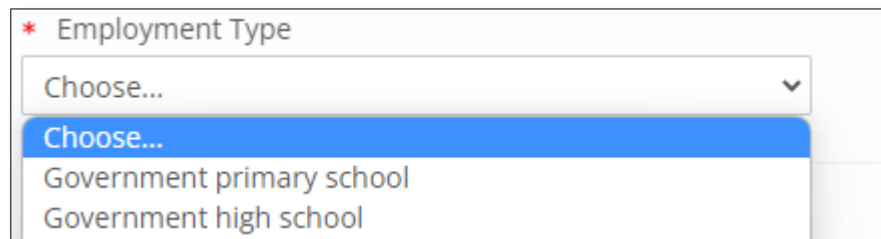
1. Visit the [ASCIA website](#)

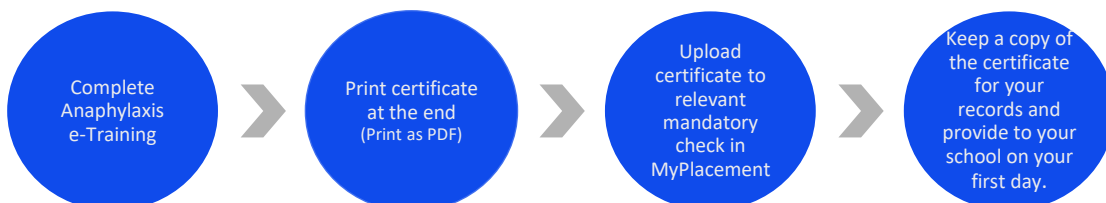
3. Select *Create new account*
4. Complete all required information, then in the **Information** section answer all required fields and answer the following fields as follows.

↳ **Employment Type:** Government primary school OR Government secondary school



↳ **Employment/School Name:** University of Technology Sydney

5. Complete the anaphylaxis e-training and print the certificate upon completion, its best to print as PDF so you have a soft copy of the certificate.
6. Upload the PDF certificate and enter the expiry date in the relevant Mandatory Check in MyPlacement and submit.
7. Provide a copy of your Anaphylaxis e-Training Certificate to your allocated school prior to placement



## Important Information

- Validation of the Certificate will occur once you demonstrate the correct use of a trainer EpiPen at your placement school.
- Anaphylaxis training needs to be completed every two (2) years.
- The link above will take you to the Australasian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy (ASCIA).
- You can complete refresher training every 6 months, please note: this does not replace the ASCIA e-Training course. (20 minutes)
- The e-training course takes approximately 1.5 hours to complete.
