

Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students (LANTITE)

The Literacy and Numeracy Test for Teacher Education Student (LANTITE) is designed to assess initial teacher education students' personal literacy and numeracy skills to ensure teachers are well equipped to meet the demands of teaching and assist higher education providers, teacher employers and the public to have increased confidence in the skills of graduating teachers.

The test has been introduced to assess those aspects of initial teacher education students' personal literacy and numeracy skills that can be measured through an online assessment tool. ALL students enrolled in an initial teacher education course will be expected to sit and pass the test.

LANTITE can be sat at **any time** during your teacher education studies. LANTITE must be completed successfully (passed) prior to undertaking your final placement or enrolling in Professional Experience Teaching Practice 1 (PETP1) if you are in the combined Bachelor and Master of Teaching degree.

Important Information

- ACER conducts four (4) LANTITE test windows per year.
- A fee is payable each time you register and sit the test.
- Literacy and Numeracy Tests can be undertaken separately.
- There is a limit to the number of times you are able to sit a LANTITE test
