

UTS Prize Conditions of Award Andrew and Lina Gullotta UTS Community Pharmacy Award

Faculty: Graduate School of Health

This document sets out the conditions of award for the below Prize ('Prize') as well as the obligations of recipients ('Recipient') and the University of Technology Sydney ('UTS') in regards to this Prize. The administrative processes to support awarding this Prize will be managed, and may be amended, in accordance with UTS Rules, Policy and Procedures.

1. PRIZE NAME: Andrew and Lina Gullotta UTS Community Pharmacy Award

2. PURPOSE

The Andrew and Lina Gullotta UTS Pharmacy Award was established to support a first year student progressing into their second year of a Master of Pharmacy (C04252) or Master of Pharmacy (International) (C04252) who would like to pursue a career in community pharmacy.

3. VALUE AND BENEFIT

3.1 Number of Recipients:

One (1) new Recipient will be awarded the prize each year

3.2 Benefit/s to Recipient:

- The maximum total value of the Prize is \$1,500 to each Recipient.
- A certificate of award will be presented to the Recipient at the annual School of Pharmacy Gala Dinner

3.3 Payment of benefit/s:

• The Recipient will receive one payment of \$1,500 by electronic funds transfer to their nominated bank account at the beginning of their commencement into second year.

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Prize, a candidate must meet all of the following criteria:

- Continuing full-time student in the Master of Pharmacy (C04252) or Master of Pharmacy (International) (C04253); and
- Must apply using the application form; and
- Must be available to attend an interview in person or online.

5. RECIPIENT SELECTION CRITERIA

- Academic merit based on the GPA calculated from completed subjects (usually the equivalent of 60 Credit Points) in their first year of the C04252 Master of Pharmacy or C04253 Master of Pharmacy (International); and
- As demonstrated in the application and interview:
 - Motivation to succeed in the Master of Pharmacy or Master of Pharmacy (International)
 - o Articulated passion for a career in community pharmacy

6. SELECTION

Shortlisted candidates are interviewed and selected based on the above selection criteria as described in Clause 5.

Eligible candidates will be presented to a Selection Committee, made up of at least three relevant members of the UTS community, Chaired by the Head of Pharmacy (or their nominee). The Donor (or their representatives) will be invited to sit on the committee.

The selected Recipient will be formally approved or declined by the Chair of the Faculty of Heath Faculty Board based upon the selection criteria in clauses 4 and 5 as per the delegations in the Scholarships and Prizes Policy.
