Each successful application will receive seed funding of AUD \$15,000. Candidates can work individually but are encouraged to work in a team and collaboration with Australian partners.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must be Vietnamese, at least 18 years old, and living in Vietnam.
- Excellent contributions and achievements for the development of Enabling Technologies for Digital Transformation.
- Grants are awarded for research in strategic technologies and related fields, such as AI, 5G/6G, IoT, Semi-conductor, Cyber Security and Privacy, Quantum, Blockchain, and Satellite.

We will prioritize applications with potential impacts, especially in collaboration with industry partners. The candidates must submit the proposal based on the template (next page).
